- (1) I. iii. 19-20: I'll drown him dry as hay: Sleep shall neither night nor day.
21-22: Hang upon his perchouse lid - He shall live a man forbid.

- (2) I. viii. 78-80: Lady Macbeth to Macbeth,

Basically, Duncan will be killed in his sleep, in innocence, when he is resting. Macbeth will kill Duncan in his sleep, in a sense, willing sleep.

Possible Thesis: Sleep ~~as~~ as an image can mean bodily function, a necessity, op. l. a common thing among every living, still; man-made.

op. 2nd: For Macbeth, his reality is one without sleep, and for Lady Macbeth, her reality is without no sleep.





- 3) 4. Tie in with larger part of play.




Blood:
